Chief's Report

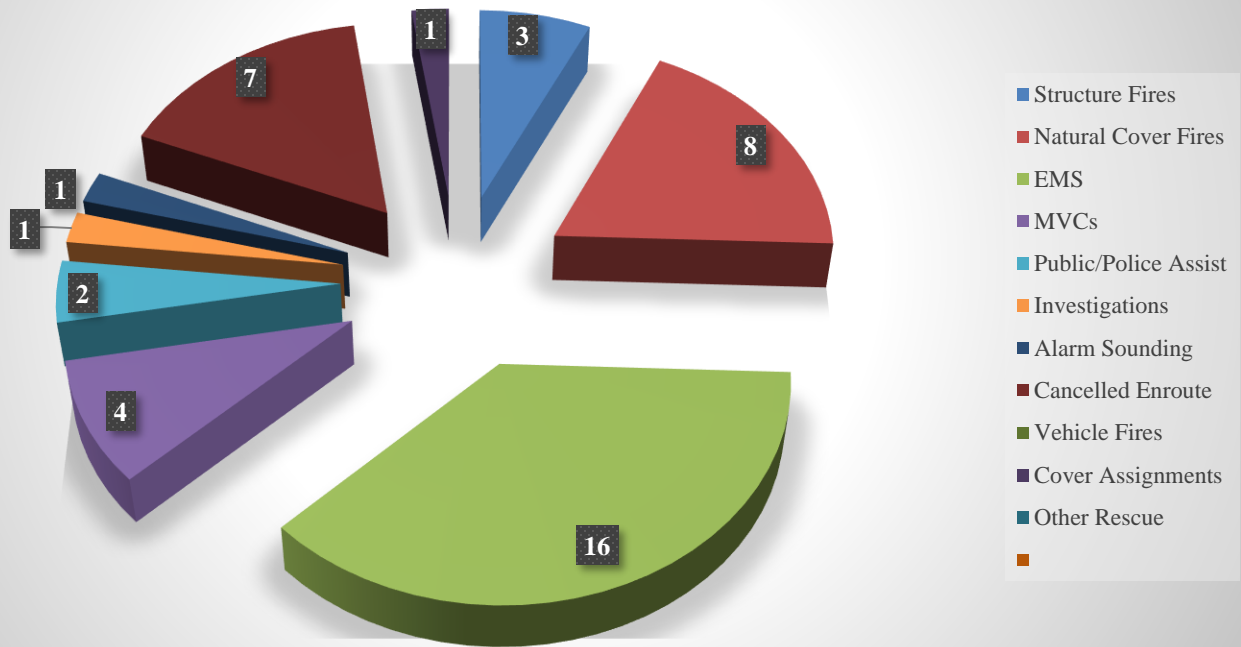
21 March, 2106

1. The District responded to 43 calls for service in the month of February 2016. This is 4 fewer runs than in February of 2015. Through the end of February, the District has made 74 responses. During the month of February District members participated in 123 training events for a total of 640.58 staff hours in training.
2. FF Baker has resigned from employment with District. Joshua Garbsion has been offered a full time position in Recruit Academy Class 16 – 04.
3. Our new bunker gear has been issued. The manufacturer did not put the proper markings on the back of the coats and they will be correcting this in the near future.
4. Recruit Academy Class 16 – 04 is scheduled to begin on Monday 28 March at 07:00 hours. We are finalizing the processing of the six (6) Recruits. We have meet with and have developed a plan to fulfill our requirements for hiring with the Tri State Alliance.
5. The field work for the 2015 audit has been completed. The auditors were very complementary of the changes that we have made in terms of modernizing our procedures. There are some details that we need to clarify and I expect the Audit to be presented during the May Board meeting.
6. I have no additional information on the sale of our Metz aerial.
7. Several of the on -going projects with Station 3 have been completed to include the generator and a new air compressor for the bays.
8. We have made significant progress on the Firehouse Inspections software program. I anticipate life safety inspections in our public assembly properties to begin by May.
9. I have applied for a position on the Peer Review Committee for the 2016 SAFER Grants.
10. I was in Orlando for the Center for Public Safety Excellence conference last week. We will begin to look at implementing some changes in our operations based on the information I was exposed to.

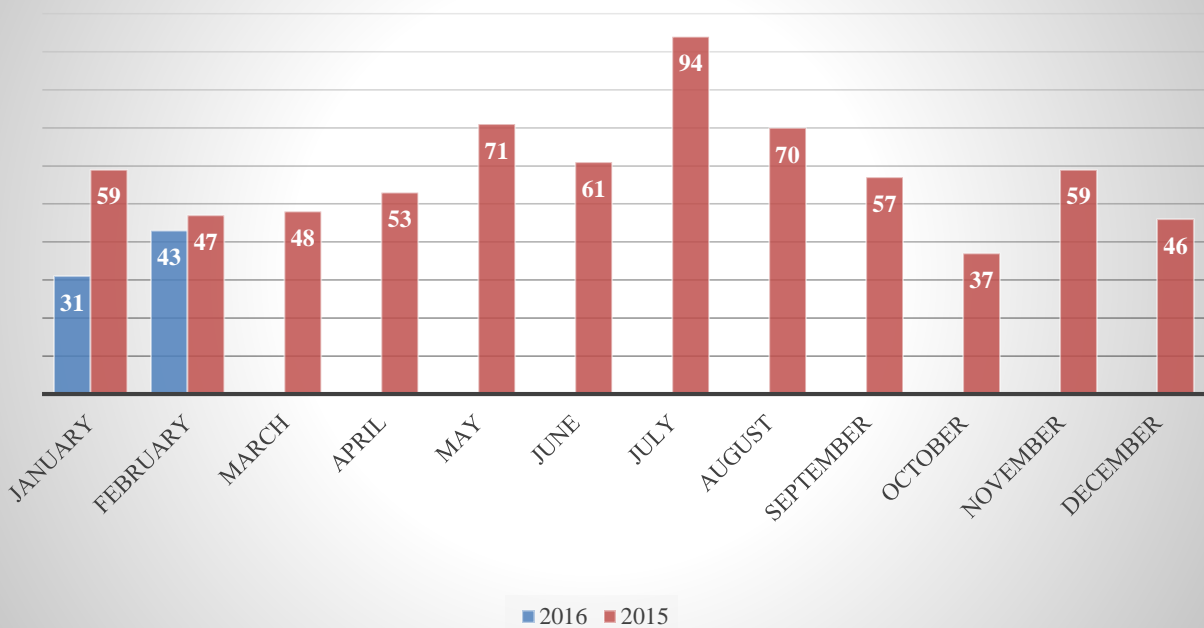
Fleet Status

- Tender 12 -34 has had the new light bar installed and the cab was wrapped.

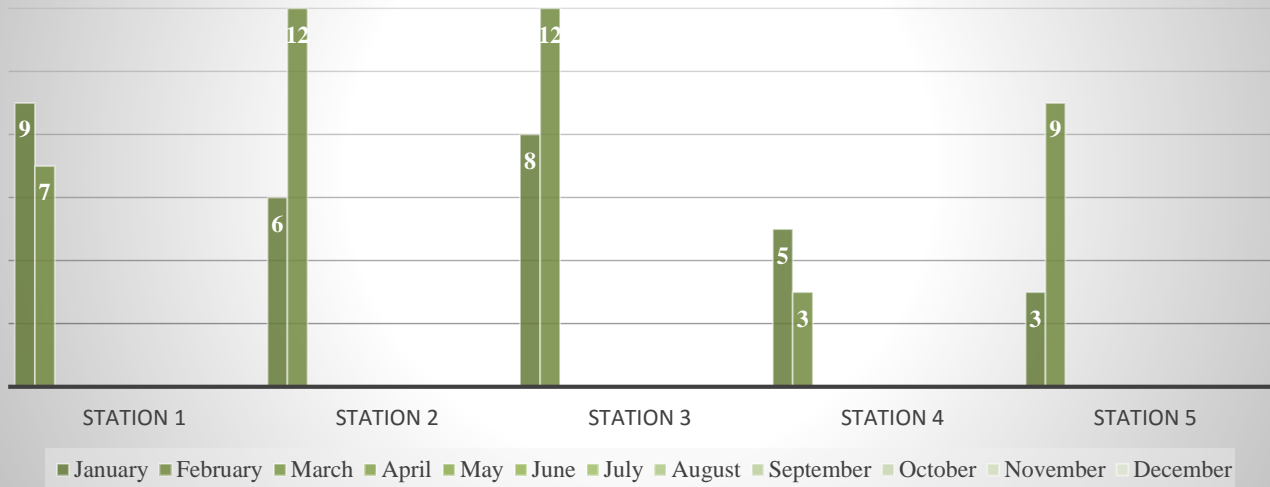
Run Distribution by Type of Incident February, 2016



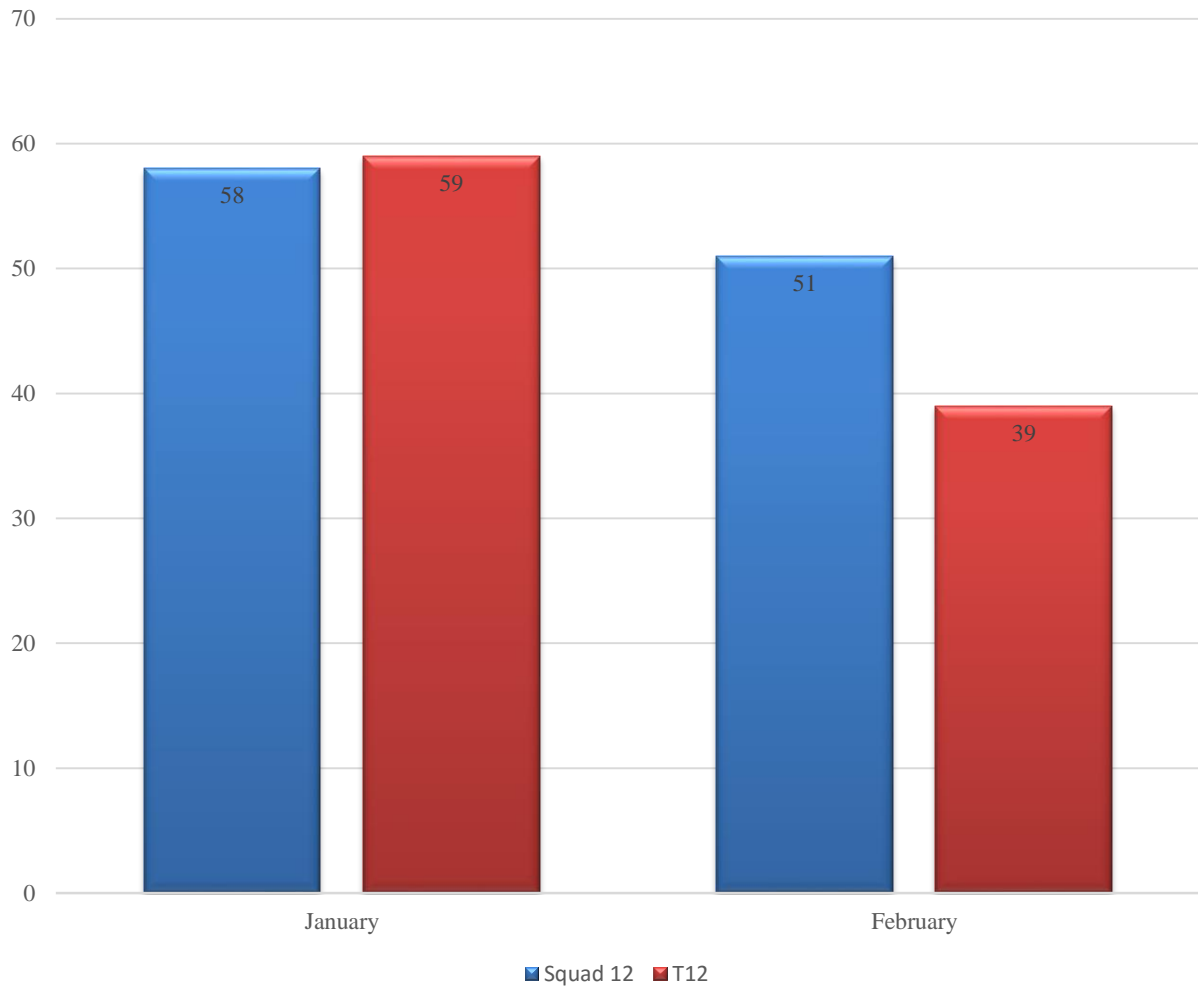
Responses per Month



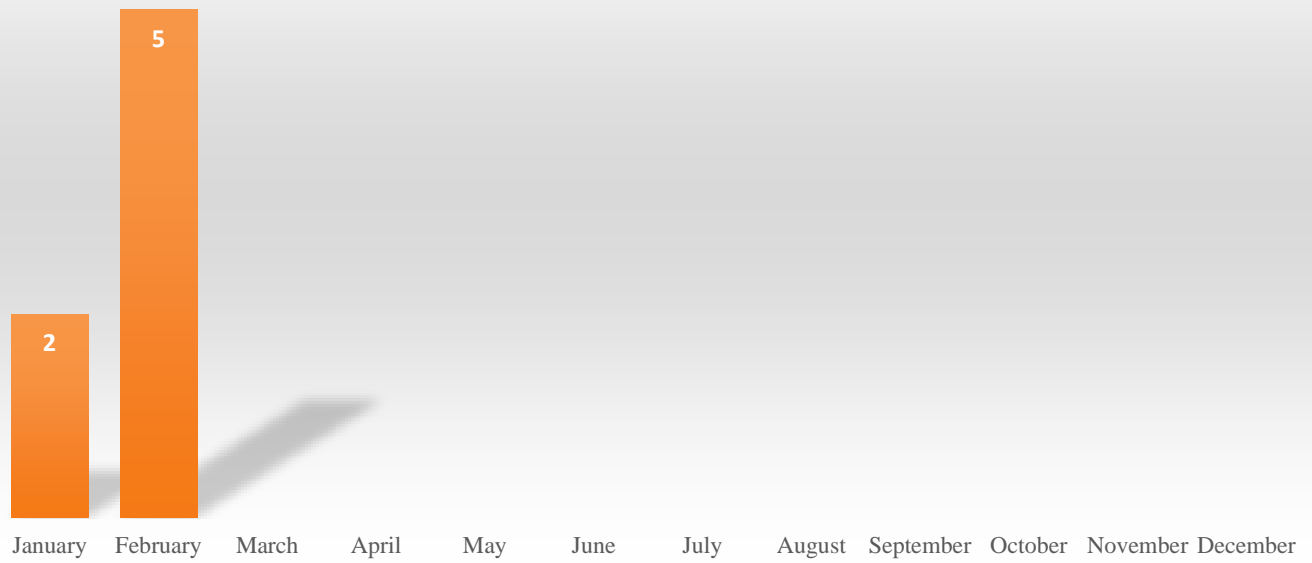
Monthly Incident Counts by Station



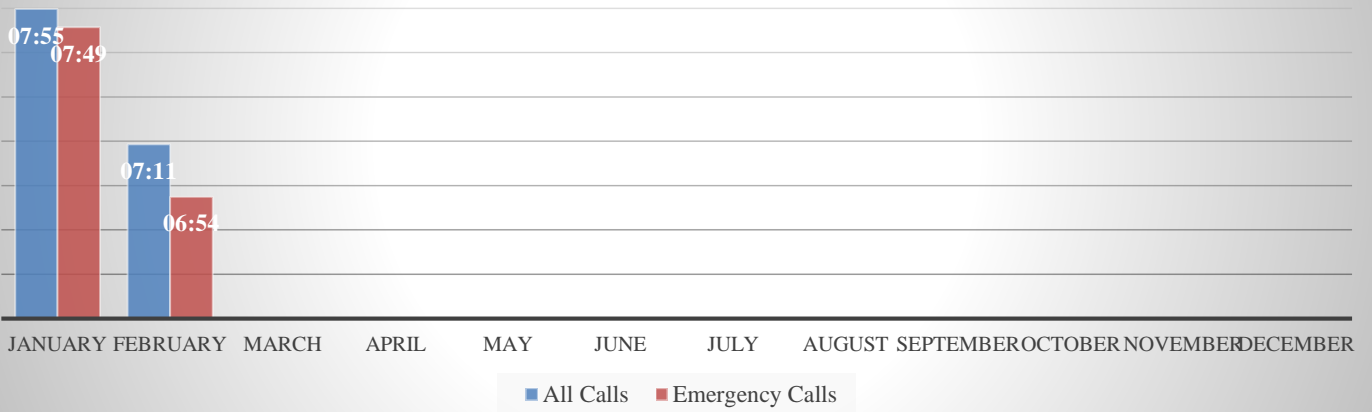
Squad 12/Truck 12 Enroute Time

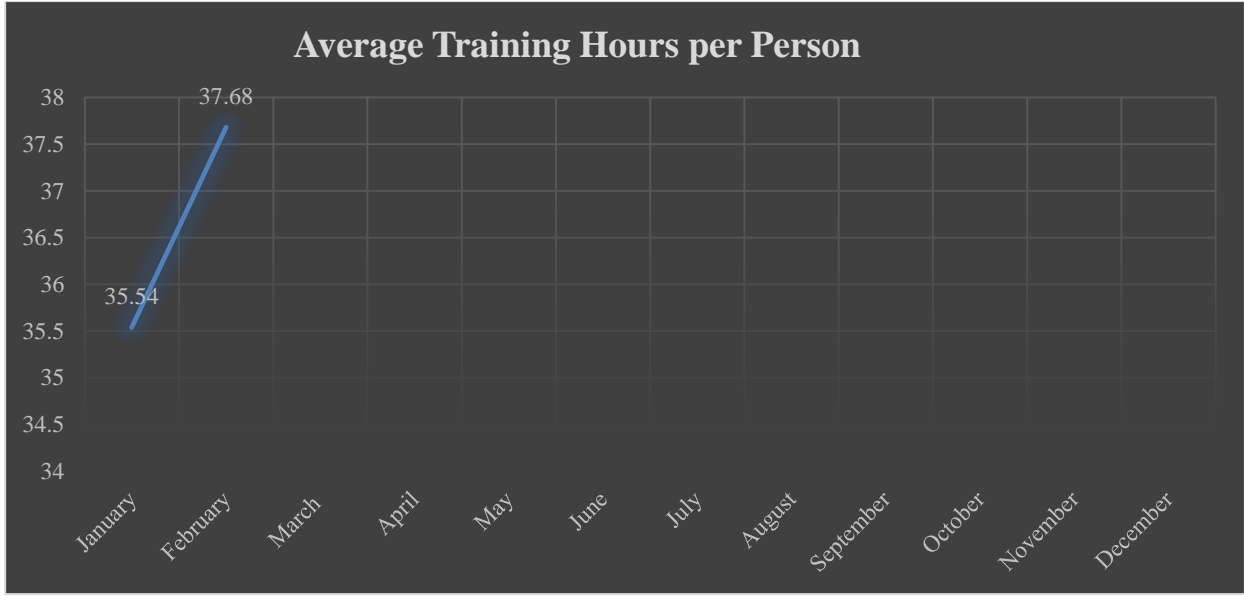


Overlapping Incidents - 2016
