Chief's Report

20 July, 2106

1. The District responded to 64 calls for service in the month of June, 2016. This is 3 more runs than in June of 2015. Through the end of June, the District has made 312 responses as compared to 339 responses in the similar period for 2015. During the month of June District members participated in 108 training events for a total of 1197 staff hours in training.
2. The District responded to a serious house fire on Woodhaven Lane last Wednesday night. A Post Incident Analysis was conducted Monday morning and several important points have been shared with the staff.
3. Captain Karl has been appointed the Interim Assistant Chief to fill the vacancy that Chief Criner's departure has created. I will keep the Board advised on this situation.
4. A Captain's Assessment Center has been announced for possible future vacancies in that grade. My goal is to establish an eligibility list that will stay in place for 2 years.
5. With A/C Karl's interim appointment the part – time dock inspector's position is once again open and we are investigating means to fill it.
6. The third session of Leadership Under Fire was conducted in Sunrise Beach on Monday 27 June. I would like to share a quote from one of the instructors:

“Chief you have the perfect storm here creating a climate of complacency. After eating lunch with your folks I can tell that's something you don't have to worry about, your people really get it.”

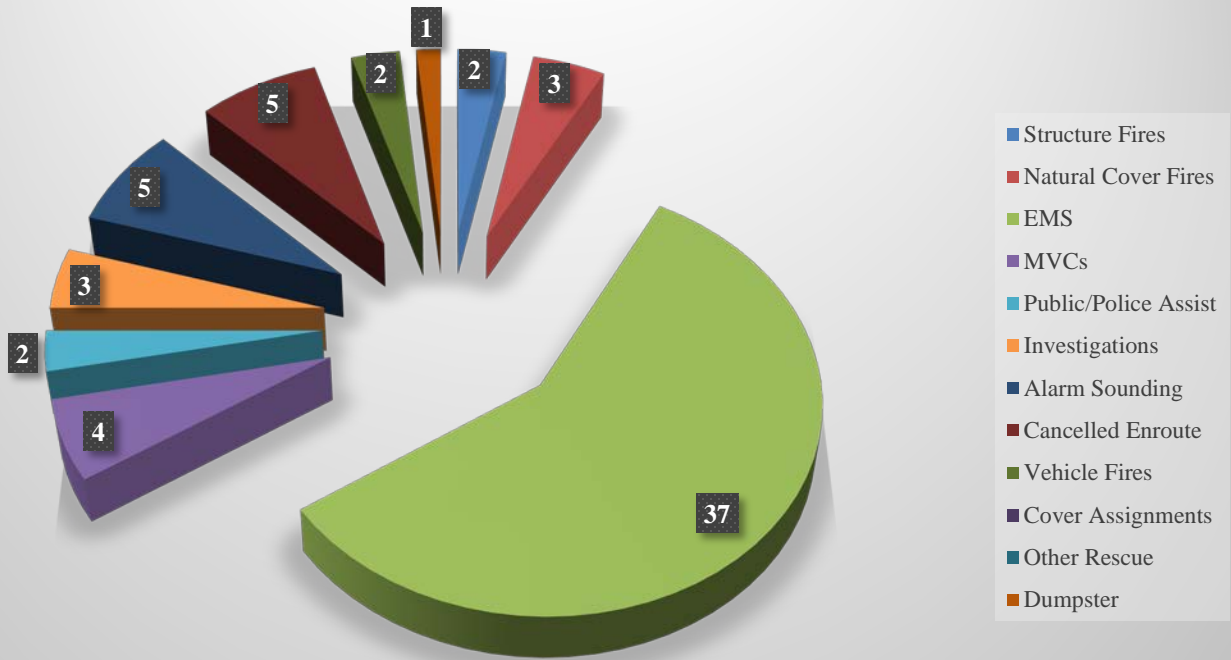

11. *In light of current events I would like to remove or except employees from the concealed carry restrictions in our facilities and on our property (excluding our apparatus).*

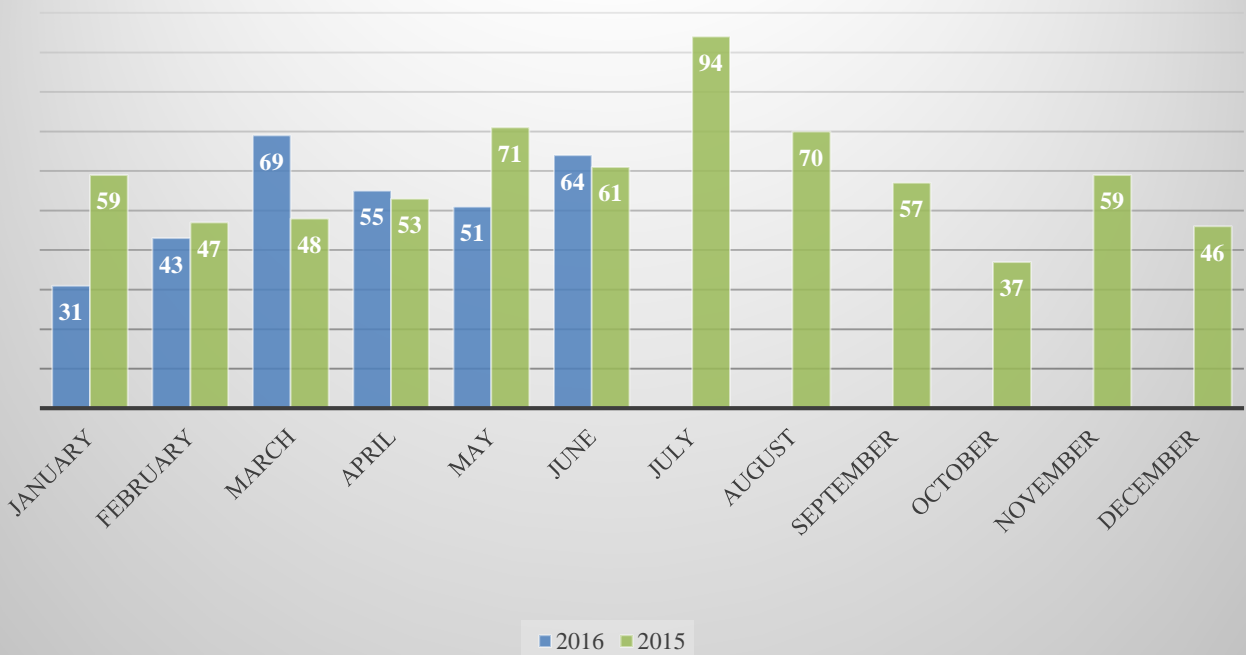

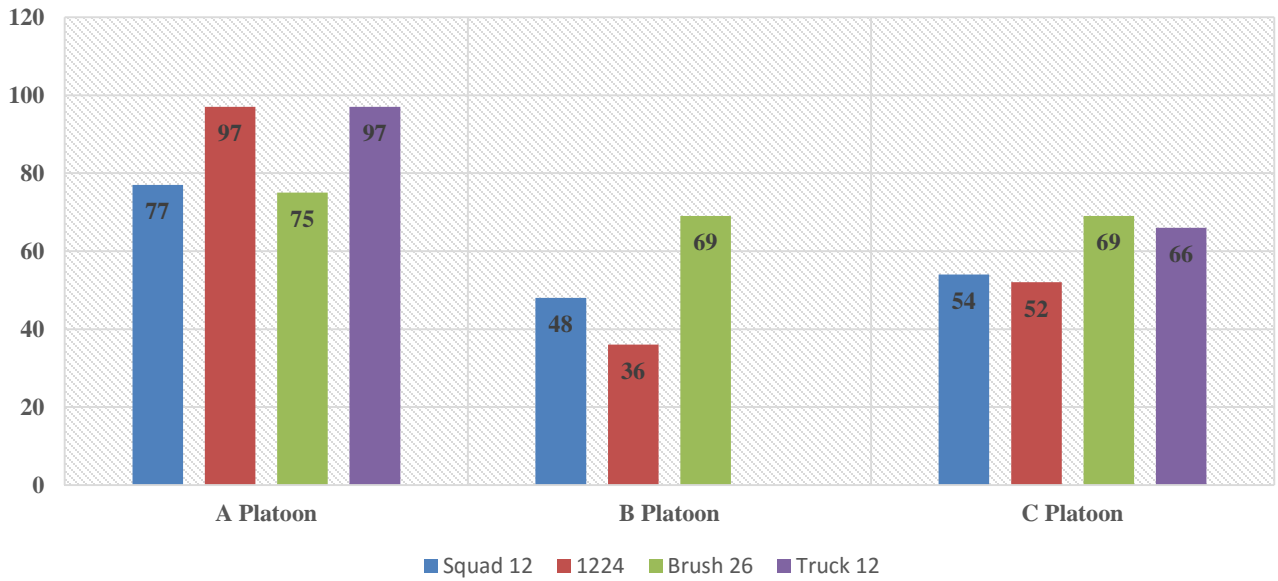
Run Distribution by Type of Incident April, 2016



Responses per Month

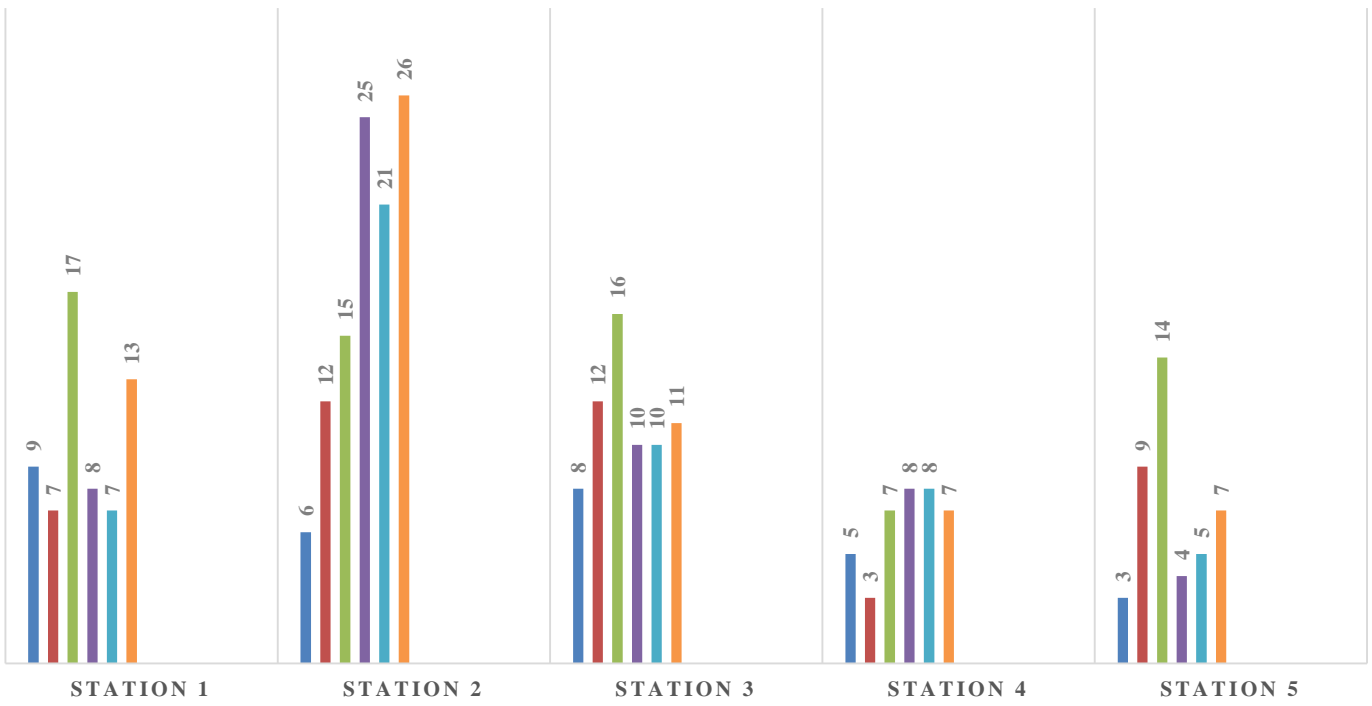


Enroute Time in Seconds



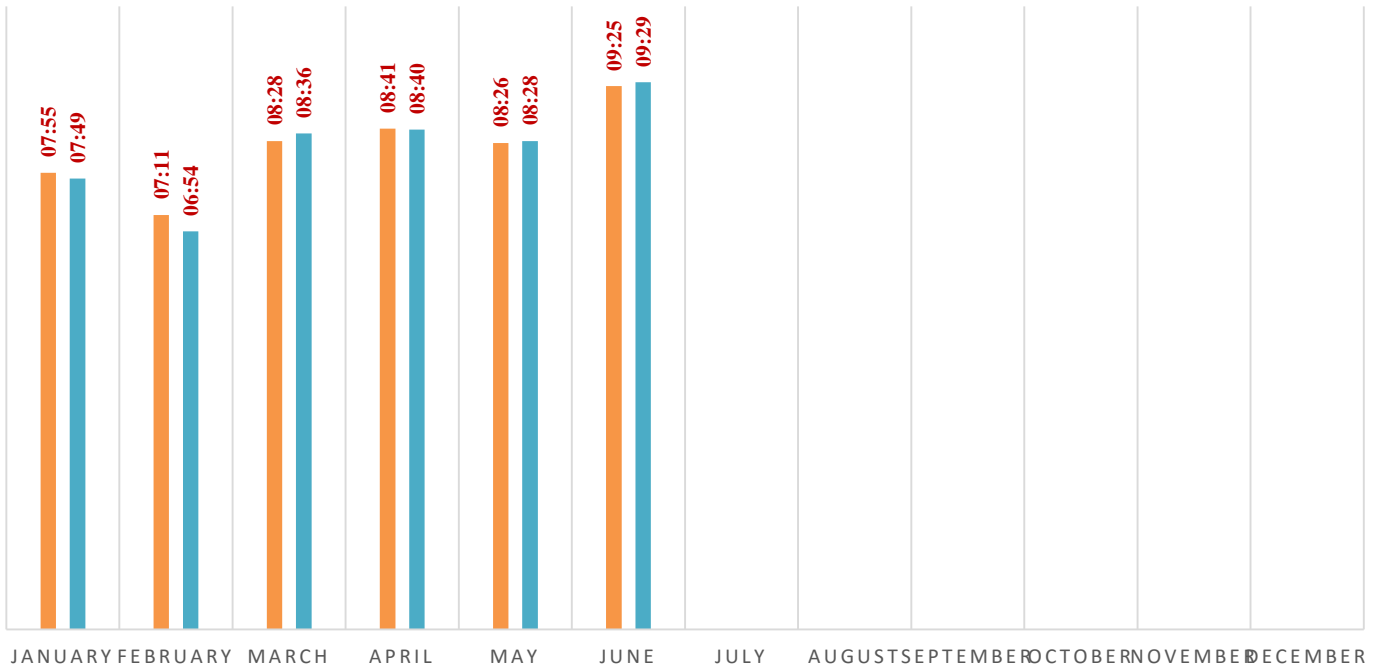
MONTHLY INCIDENT COUNTS BY STATION

January February March April May June July August September October November December



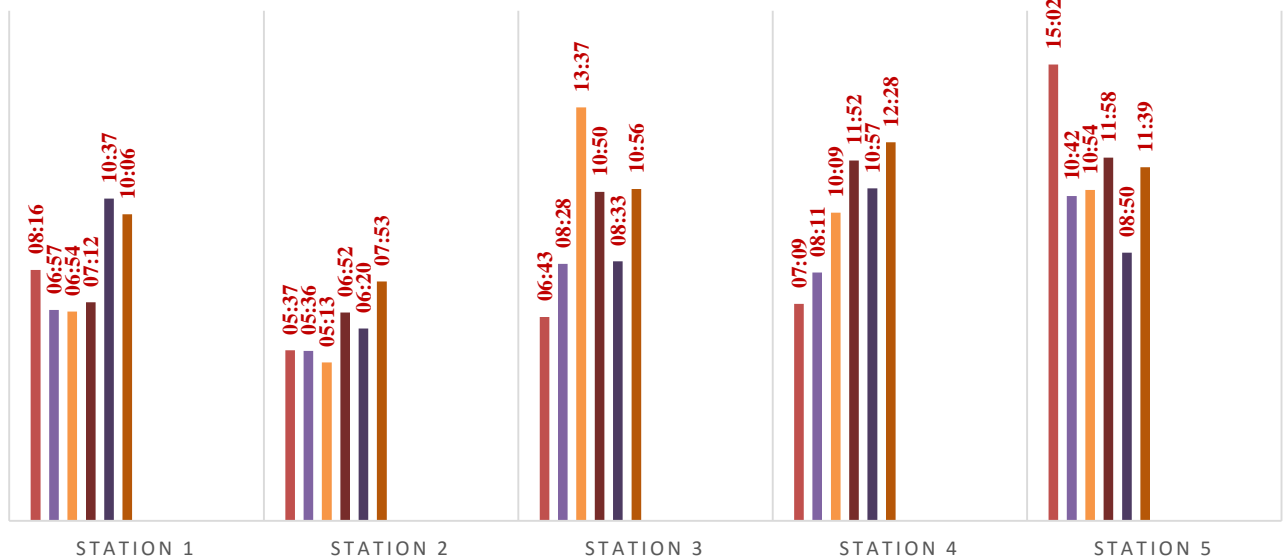
AVERAGE ON-SCENE TIME OF FIRST ARRIVING UNIT

■ All Calls ■ Emergency Calls

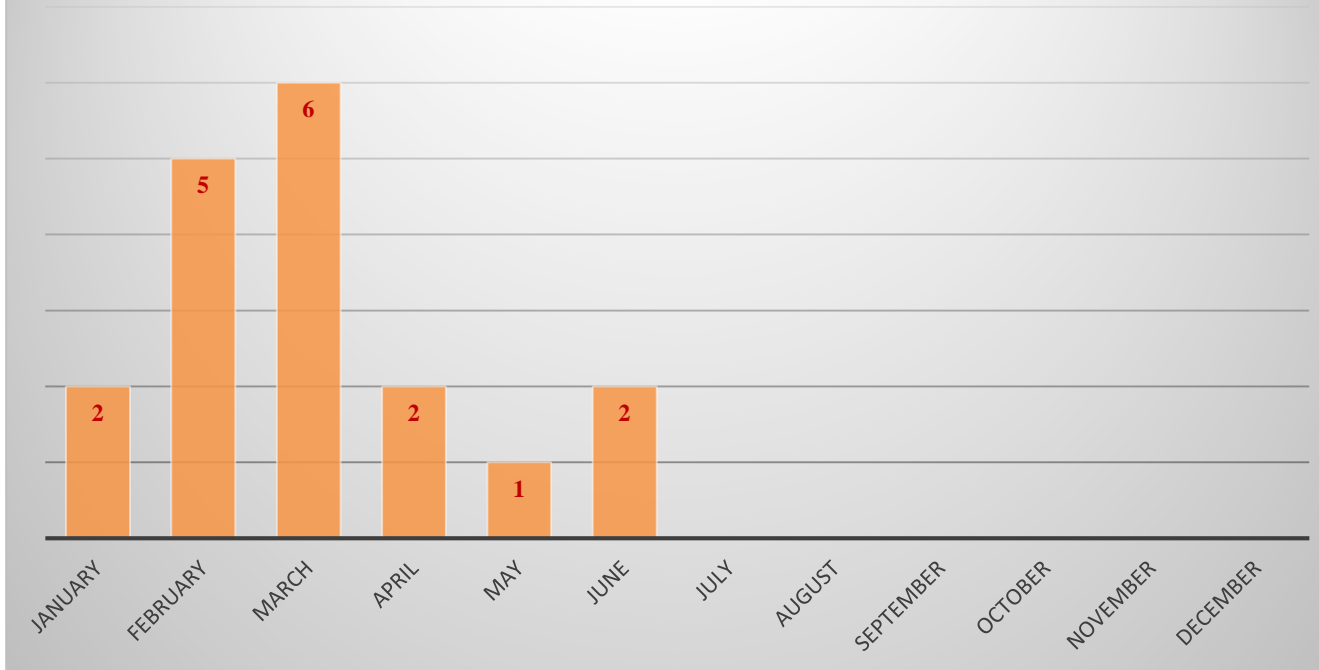


EMERGENCY INCIDENT ON-SCENE TIMES BY STATION

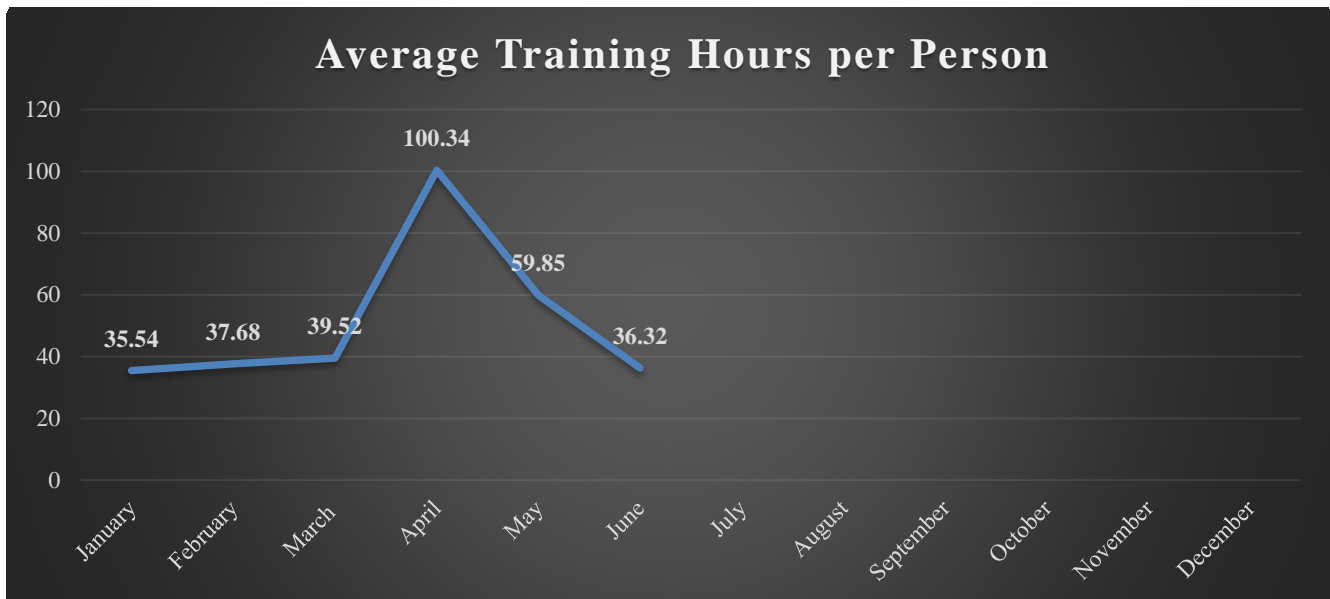
■ January ■ February ■ March ■ April ■ May ■ June ■ July ■ August ■ September ■ October ■ November ■ December



Overlapping Incidents - 2016



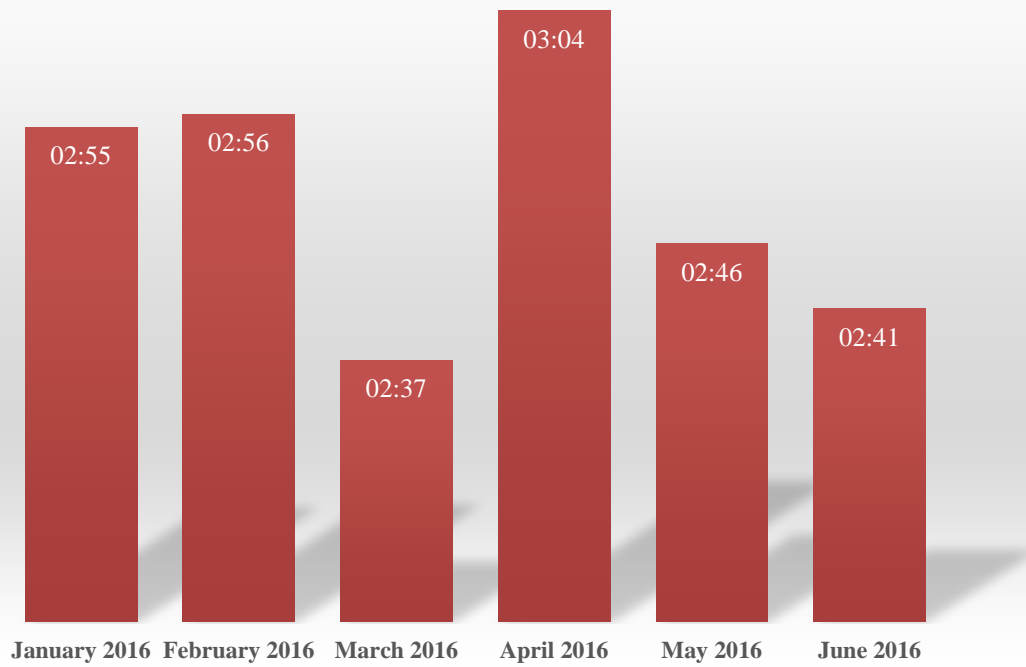
Average Training Hours per Person
